

EDHS Hawaii 2011 Luggage Drop Off Schedule

- When:
 - Friday, April 15th
 - 6:00pm and 6:45pm (By Flight Group)
- Where:
 - EDHS Front Parking Lot
- Who:
 - Those people traveling with the band including parents and siblings
 - If you are traveling on your own, we will not be responsible for your luggage

- What to bring:
 - Any bags you plan on checking (excluding carry on bags)
 - Please have your name, address and phone number on each bag including instruments. Suitcases must have the Hawaii Invitational luggage tag which will be distributed Wednesday, April 4th at school. Instruments should have a luggage tag provided by you.

When you arrive at the school, you will need to bring have your name(s) checked off of the roster of travelers on each flight. Please only come at your assigned time as we will be loading the bags by flight group. Before you are checked off, your bag will be checked to be sure it is labeled correctly and you will be asked a few important questions (such as: Did you pack your marching shoes?) Once your name is checked off, we will put a piece of colored tape and labels on your bags that will help identify which airline and flight you are traveling on. The following is the order of the drops:

6:00pm Group 2: American Airlines Flight # 297

6:450pm Groups 1A & 1B: Hawaiian Air Flight # 1

Please note:

1. This is the ONLY opportunity you will have to drop off your luggage for the trip.
2. Please pack conservatively (You should only need light clothing for the tropical climate)
3. Once your bags are in the trailer, they will not be accessible until you get to the airport. So, wallets, money, cell phones etc. will need to stay with you.
4. If you have a small instrument such as a flute or clarinet, they will need to be packed in your suitcase or carry on, so leave room for them.
5. Those of you with midsized instruments such as a trumpet or similar size are encouraged to carry them on the flight if they will fit in the storage compartments. Carry on's can be no larger than 9" x 14" x 22".
6. Instruments larger than trumpets, will need to be placed in the checked in baggage.
7. If you are taking more than one instrument, please determine how they will be handled. If it is small enough that it can be checked, we will ask another band member who is not checking an instrument to check it for you.
